

Skwachàys Lodge - Hotel and Gallery COVID-19 Safety Plan

All guests, customers and visitors must adhere to the following protocols for the
Skwachàys Lodge - Hotel, Gallery and Welcome Room

- Occupancy in the Gallery and Front Desk area are limited to 4 guests, visitors, artists or volunteers, at any one time.
- Occupancy in the Welcome Room located at the rear of the Gallery is limited to 15 people for meetings at any one time.
- You will be notified by staff if the Gallery and Front Desk are at limit and be asked to wait, appropriately distanced on the sidewalk outside the Lodge and Gallery entrance until occupancy limits allow you to enter.
- At all times maintain a distance of 2 meters from other guests, customers, visitors, artists, volunteers or staff.
- Skwachàys Lodge prohibits entry by anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms or has had COVID-19 symptoms in the last 10 days or has arrived from outside Canada within the last 14 days, or anyone under the direction of the Provincial Health Officer to self-isolate.
- All are requested to follow directional arrows while in the Lodge and Gallery and if checking in or purchasing goods, please line up using the floor markers.
- Guests are requested to handle their own luggage at all times.
- Customers are encouraged not to handle merchandise that they are not intending to purchase and customer fitting rooms are not available.
- The Welcome Room located at the rear of the Galley is available for guests, however the 6th floor meeting room, sweat lodge and garden area are not available for guests at this time.
- Deliveries and any visitor or artist with business in the Gallery must adhere to these protocols.
- Please practice proper respiratory etiquette and use Hand Sanitizer Stations upon entry to the Lodge and Gallery and upon use of elevators and the Welcome Room.
- Guests and customers may choose and are encouraged to wear non-medical masks, if they feel that physical distancing is, at any time, not possible.
